- American Cancer Society** - Provides no-cost transportation to medical appointments for cancer patients.
- American Red Cross of Central Maryland** - Supports 80 percent of disaster relief efforts and emergency services.
- American Heart Association** - Supports awareness education for heart disease and stroke prevention.
- Catholic Charities of Baltimore** - Supports individuals and families with meals, shelter, and critical basic need services.

- Annapolis Area Ministries** - Provides basic needs to homeless and at-risk individuals.

 - Arundel House of Hope** - Supports shelter and health care at the Homeless Resource and Day Center.
 - Chrysalis House** - Provides supportive services to women receiving treatment for drug abuse.
 - Legal Aid Bureau** - Helps prevent low-income families from becoming homeless.
 - Partners in Care** - Helps older adults maintain their independence.
 - Sarah's House, Catholic Charities of Baltimore** - Provides education and computer classes for homeless individuals.
 - The Center of Help** - Supports The Building Lives for New Americans program for Latino residents.
 - The Salvation Army, Greater Baltimore Area Command** - Supports at-risk youth at the Glen Burnie Boys & Girls Clubs.
 - YWCA of Annapolis and Anne Arundel County** - Provides safe shelter and legal support to domestic violence victims at Arden House.

COMMUNITY RESPONSE GRANTEES:

Community response grants provide up to \$7,500 quarterly for programmatic and immediate needs.

- Anne Arundel County CASA, Inc.** - Supports volunteer training for Court Appointed Special Advocates.
- Anne Arundel County Department of Social Services** - Supports follow up appointments for Homeless Resource Day.
- Maryland Coalition Against Sexual Assault** - Provides legal services to victims of child sex abuse.
- Moveable Feast** - Provides nutritious food for home-bound clients.
- Omni House** - Supports critical building repairs.
- Service Coordination, Inc.** - Provides client financial assistance funds.
- The Center of Help** - Supports outreach and marketing efforts of client education series.
- The Salvation Army, Greater Baltimore Area Command** - Supports eviction prevention at the North Anne Arundel Family Service Center.

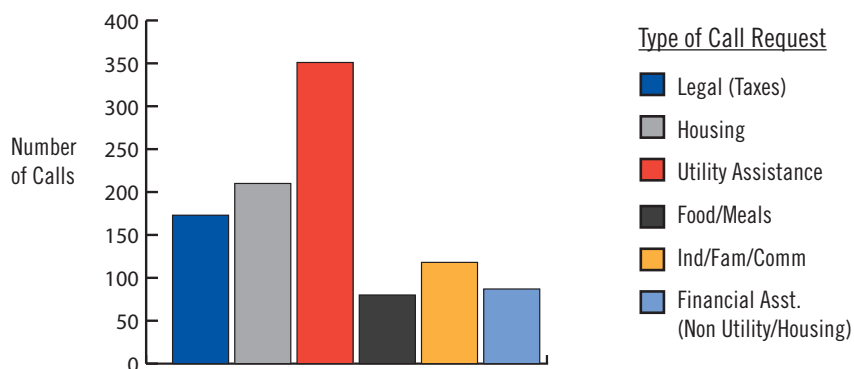
